## Title of the Best Practice - COVID 19 relief programmes organised by college

#### **Best Practice II**

Title of the Practice - Using inclusivist practices of teaching learning in the online mode

# Context

A large number of the students belong to the lower income families and were hugely impacted by the crisis caused by COVID 19. It was necessary for the teachers of the Sarsuna College to develop a means that would enable maximum participation of the students in the classroom activities.

#### The Practice

The teachers were encouraged by the IQAC to use the most common and least expensive forms of social media to reach out to the students.

Most of the teachers used whatsapp voice and video messages, along with text messages for reaching out to the students. While platforms like G Meet and Zoom required high speed internet, the whatsapp messages could be easily downloaded at the convenience of the students.

The teachers therefore, shared the texts, whose pdf was available, instructions for certain activities through voice and video messages and screen recording. Scripts and practical work were corrected directly on soft copies through pen devices of certain devices and screen recorders were also used to explain faults of work and give guidelines. Links to various websites like You Tube lectures and academic sites were also shared through whatsapp chats.

## **Problems Encountered**

It was still difficult to reach out to each and every student. Also many students were not sincere enough to immediately access the given materials.

### **Evidence of Success**

More number of students started taking an interest in the class studies. There was a surge of number of students even in the online classes that were scheduled in G meet.
