REPORT ON WEBINARS CONDUCTED BY SARSUNA COLLEGE, 2020-21

- One Day State level Webinar was conducted by the Commerce Dept of Sarsuna College on 22.9.2020. The topic was **"Economy and Education in Post Covid New Normal".** The Resource Person was Prof. Ananda Mohan Pal, Professor, Department of Business Management, University of Calcutta. There were 50 participants. The main point of discussion was the abrupt and profound changes on education due to COVID pandemic. He also highlighted the point of economic crisis within countries for COVID which lead to fiscal austerity and increase in poverty. In a developing country like India Online education is creating a disparity within students due to technology shortage, connectivity and affordability issues, limited computer literacy, insecurity etc. These major problems were discussed by the speaker nicely. His suggestion was to create a strong and balanced online educational platform in our country where no students would be deprived of education.
- A National Webinar on "Virtual library services during COVID 19: Challenges and Ways" was organised by Info- lib Academia collaboration with Sarsuna College on 1st September 2020.
